<u>Aim</u>

1. To provide health cover to students in the light of IMS procedures and PMDC's regulations.

<u>Scope</u>

2. This SOP covers documenting guiding procedures for provision of health care to BDS students of this institute including emergency & planned treatments, admissions in HIT Hospital and purchase of medicines and equipment.

Health Cover

3. Following policy for the medical treatment of students in HIT Hospital was approved in the Academic Council Meeting, held on Thursday, 27th Jun, 2019, Taxila:-

- a. All consultations and emergency treatment will be free charges.
- b. Medicine will be provided only in admission cases.

Procedure

4. Students will report in Student Affairs Department, to get permission letter for treatment in HIT Hospital, on which they will be able to get their treatment.

5. Department of Student Affairs will inform parents / guardians about the health issue of student via phone call / request to visit college / immediately in case of emergencies.
